INSTRUCTIONS

- Funds will be sent to the institution shown on page 1. No funds will be given directly to the applicant.
- Only one scholarship per applicant will be awarded per twelve month period.
- Applicant will be notified in writing if application is approved.

Applicant shall be responsible for providing the Scholarship Committee with all information requested herein prior to scholarship payment.

GUIDELINES AND ELIGIBILITY

1. Only one scholarship per applicant will be awarded within a twelve (12) month period.
2. A maximum amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per applicant shall be awarded.
3. Additional funds may be awarded to members pursuing advanced degrees in Lutheran theological education.
4. This fund is not intended to be used for continuing education course work.
5. The scholarship will be awarded to students attending an accredited institution of higher education or an accredited vocational school.
6. Awarded to applicants that are members in good standing of St. Peter Lutheran Church in Walburg, Texas.
7. Application must be submitted at least sixty (60) days prior to the start of term or semester to be reimbursed.
8. All applications will be kept for only as long as administratively necessary (maximum of three years) and then will be destroyed.
